Warehouses, Compresses and other Central Collection Points:

On behalf of the cotton producers of Texas, we want to thank you for your help in collecting the 2017 Boll Weevil Eradication Maintenance Fee for cotton produced in the West Texas Maintenance Area (WTMA) and the East Texas Maintenance Area (ETMA). We know for those of you handling ETMA cotton, this was a new process requiring adjustments to your tariff collection procedures and some effort by you to help implement this important and necessary change. We appreciate your patience and help in making administration of this collection process as efficient as possible. Your assistance allows Texas cotton producers to continue to protect the tremendous investment made to eradicate the boll weevil.

2018 Maintenance Fees

For the 2018 cotton crop, the Commissioner of Agriculture set the annual maintenance fees at the following rates:

ETMA

For cotton produced in 2018, ETMA's maintenance fee was lowered to \$2.00 per bale.

WTMA

For cotton produced in 2018, WTMA's maintenance fee remains at \$1.00 per bale.

Enclosed you will find a map (Attachment A) showing the two Texas maintenance areas as well as a listing of counties located in each maintenance area (Attachments B and C). The maintenance fees should be included in the tariff or schedule of fees, but by law must be collected on all bales produced in the respective maintenance area. Sample tariff language is included in Attachment D.

Maintenance Fees Collected at First Central Collection Point

In accordance with the law, maintenance fees shall be collected at the first central collection points that receive and ship cotton produced in the maintenance area. Central collection points include all cotton warehouses, cotton compresses and other venues collecting harvested and ginned cotton that was produced within a maintenance area. Central collection point shall include a cotton gin **only** when:

- a) The cotton in question ships directly from the gin to a user or exporter of cotton, and is not stored at a domestic warehouse or compress, and then only for those bales that ship directly; or
- b) When a cotton gin agrees to serve as a central collection point.

The "first handler" warehouse is responsible for collecting the maintenance fee on all bales grown in a maintenance area. However, if a bale was ginned at a location acting as the central collection point, the warehouse will not be required to collect the maintenance fee as long as reasonable evidence can be provided that the fee was collected at the gin.

If a bale is ginned at a location not acting as a central collection point, the first warehouse that receives the bale is obligated to collect the maintenance fee. If the bale is later shipped to another warehouse as a result of "reconstitution" or any other reason, the subsequent warehouse is not responsible for collecting maintenance fees provided the warehouse is in possession of commercially reasonable evidence showing a prior warehouse has already remitted the maintenance fee.

Remittance Dates

Maintenance fees are due to the Foundation by March 1, 2019 for all bales sold and shipped, and the tariff paid, by February 15, 2019. Fees for bales shipped by May 15th are due June 1st and fees for bales shipped by September 15th are due to the Foundation by October 1st.

The following table summarizes shipping cutoff dates and the corresponding remittance dates for the year's maintenance fees.

Bale Shipped Cutoff Date	Remittance Due Date
February 15, 2019	March 1, 2019
May 15, 2019	June 1, 2019
September 15, 2019	October 1, 2019

Remittance Forms

Refunds

In the event a central collection point collects and remits a maintenance fee on cotton bales that were NOT produced in a Texas maintenance area, the cotton producer should submit a refund request to the Foundation along with support documentation showing that the fee was paid on cotton produced outside a maintenance area. Upon receipt of the refund request and adequate supporting documentation, the Foundation will issue a maintenance fee refund to the producer.

The formation of maintenance areas has been very successful, a success owed in large part to the cooperation shown by the Warehouses, Compresses and other central collection points. Transitioning to the maintenance area model is critical to the continued success of boll weevil eradication efforts in Texas and to the protection of the \$1.2 billion investment made by Texas cotton growers and the state and federal legislatures.

The Foundation and TDA are committed to making the administration of the collection process of maintenance fees as simple and effective as possible. I appreciate your help in making this program more efficient for our state's cotton producers.


